



ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) EXAMS 2017

What	At the conclusion of an AP course, students have the opportunity to take the corresponding AP Exam. AP Exams are two to three hour exams that consist of multiple choice and free response (essay) questions. They are graded on a scale of 1-5. A score of 3, 4, or 5 is usually considered a qualifying score for college units. Testing locations will be announced during the pre-administration session.
Where	AP Exams will be held at John F. Kennedy High School.
When	May 1, 2017- May 12, 2017 during the school day. Specific test information is online at collegeboard.com and on the back of the Bulletin for AP Students and Parents .
Who	JFK students prepared to participate in AP testing.
Why	If a student receives a qualifying score on an AP Exam, he/she may be eligible for advanced placement or course credits at the vast majority of colleges and universities in the United States. More than 1,400 institutions in the United States grant a full year's credit to students with satisfactory grades on AP Exams.
Cost	<u>\$93 per exam</u> Payment must be received for the full amount for each exam taken. Please do not register unless you plan to take the exam. Complete refunds will not be given and only cash or check will be accepted for payment. Checks are payable to: John F Kennedy High School. Reduced fees are available for students with financial need.

Registration

* Registration window is March 6th -10th, 2017 during lunch or after school until 4 pm. Students who wish to register for the test(s) must bring a check or cash and student ID to the controller's office. Please don't wait until the last day! Make sure to **SAVE YOUR RECEIPT**. It is your proof of payment. **BRING YOUR RECEIPT ON THE DAY OF THE TEST.**

**Financial need can be easily determined by a student's eligibility for the free/reduced lunch program. If you think you might qualify, see Mrs. Brown in the office for the waiver form as soon as possible. Parents/guardians need to submit a copy of a completed tax form for tax year 2016. (If 2016 taxes are not completed, 2015 can be used). Waivers are only available to students who are currently taking the AP class in which they want to test.
