### 2016-17 Scholarship Instructions

Formed in 1999, the Gene Haas Foundation supports a variety of programs, particularly in the technical and engineering fields at schools, colleges and universities worldwide. To augment the Foundation's work, Haas Automation established a worldwide network of Haas Technical Education Centers, which play a vital role in many local training centers, community colleges and universities. Students learn machining and metalworking skills through a hands-on approach, using the types of Haas CNC machine tools they will encounter upon entering the workforce. This scholarship is for students attending a college or university with a degree in engineering, manufacturing or other highly technical career.

### GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

You must be a graduating senior enrolled in the Manufacturing and Design pathway, have at least a 3.0 GPA and be enrolled in college for the Fall of 2017 to apply. Please include the following items in your application:

- A single page, typed letter about yourself. Please include how being a student in MaD has prepared you for college, your career goals and a summery of financial need.
- Two letters of recommendation. One letter should be from a current teacher of your choice.
- A current transcript.
- Proof of college acceptance.
