2016-2017 Scholarship Instructions

The John T. Braxton Memorial Scholarship honors a graduating senior at John F. Kennedy High School. Recipients will be chosen on the basis of academic achievement, citizenship, and student activities such as athletic and clubs.

Coach Braxton was a member of the original staff when Kennedy High School opened in 1967, becoming a Vice Principal in 1973. During his high school experience, he was an outstanding student, excelling in football, basketball, track, drama, music, debate, and public speaking.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

You must be a graduating senior, have at least a 2.5 GPA, be a student athlete, thespian, musician, or debater. Funds will be made available to the scholarship recipient upon confirmation of the student's enrollment in an institution of higher learning. Please submit only one application. Include the following items in your application:

- A single page, typed letter about yourself. Please include how being a student athlete, thespian, musician, or debater at Kennedy has prepared you for college. (Please make sure you answer the following prompts: Describe your student activities and the roles you play in them. Include what you find most rewarding.)
- Two letters of recommendation. One letter from a current teacher of your choice and one letter from a current J. F. Kennedy High School coach or community leader.
- A current transcript.
