    - This will not impact any financial aid you receive.
  - Household size
    - If you live in more than one house, choose the one you are in most.
  - Yes/No questions -- Answer each question as it pertains to **you**.
    - Are you enrolling in fewer than six units this semester?
      - **Answer: NO**
    - Do you have a long term objective to earn a certificate or degree at either a two-year or four-year college/university?
      - **Answer: YES**
