Please remember that participating in the graduation ceremony is a privilege and not a right. Seniors on an Attendance Contract (SART) will be closely monitored until last scheduled class. If the contract is violated, the student will not be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

You will not be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony if you violate school rules and/or Education Codes, if you are on suspension between **January 29 – June 8, 2018** or if you **exceed 5 unexcused absences**, during the same time frame. (Unexcused absences = UNV, OTHR or TRNT in the attendance record). Seniors that are currently on an Attendance Contract (SART) cannot miss any periods.

Only traditional caps, gowns, academic NHS, NAHS, and CSF cowls and colors allowed. No leis, additional colors, cloths, hats etc. are to be worn during graduation. Students should dress appropriately (semi-formal).

Graduates are not allowed to bring any hand-held items such as purses, Yearbooks, flower bouquets etc. **Noisemakers, balloons, banners and signs are strictly forbidden.**

Graduates are expected to conduct themselves in an appropriate and dignified manner. Seniors must be present for rehearsal. You will receive your name/photo cards at this time.

Graduation: Commencement will be held on Wednesday **June 13, 2018 at 3:00 pm** at the Memorial Auditorium at 16th and J Streets. Parking info – www.cityofsacramento.org/transportation/parking.

Please remind guests that Commencement begins at 3:00 pm sharp. Doors will open at approximately 2:15 pm and close at 2:50 pm. Doors will reopen once all seniors are seated. Following the ceremonies, you will receive your diploma in the basement of Memorial Auditorium. You are responsible for your diploma, there are no duplicate diplomas given.

TICKETS INFORMATION:

Admission will be by ticket only, one ticket per person. Children age 2 and under do not need a ticket as long as they sit on the parents' lap. Strollers are not allowed on the auditorium floor.

It is imperative to return your completely signed check out form to the registrar to be able to claim your graduation tickets. Only graduating seniors with a JFK school ID may pick up tickets in the Registrar's office on **June 11 & 12**. Times for pick-up will be posted in the front office. Parents/Guardians cannot pick up tickets.

Each senior participating in graduation ceremonies will receive **5 free tickets** only. No extra tickets will be sold or distributed by Kennedy High.

OTHER INFORMATION:

Seniors entering college in the fall of 2018 must request official transcripts from the Registrar's Office to be sent to the school they will be attending. The first 2 transcripts are free; additional copies are \$5.00 each.

PHOTOGRAPHS:

Color photographs will be taken of the graduates as they cross the stage and receive their diplomas. Order envelopes will be available on June 13th during rehearsal.
