COURSE SELECTION DATE (by ENGLISH CLASS PERIOD)

On this day, counselors will be present with student transcripts to assist individual students in choosing their 11th grade classes for the 2018/2019 school year.

Once again it is time for students to select their courses for the next school year. Counselors will be meeting individually with current 11th grade students the *first week in March* to guide them through the initial course selection process. Later in the spring, these course selections will be printed and given to students, and parent(s)/guardian(s) for a final review. If changes or corrections are needed, the student may submit a *Course Change Form* to their assigned counselor. The **Post-Selection Course Change Request Form** can be found in the counseling office or on the JFK website: www.jfk.scusd.edu.

In order for students to accurately choose courses, it is important for students and parent(s)/guardian(s) to review the course selection materials carefully before counselor-student scheduling days. Course information materials are available on the JFK website (www.jfk.scusd.edu) under *Course Selections 2017/2018*, or in the JFK Counseling Office. Resources include the course catalog, which contains course descriptions, prerequisites, college entry information, graduation requirements, learning academy plans; A-G for UC/CSU approved course lists and sample schedules. While using these resources, please follow the recommended procedure for completing the course selection sheet on the other side of this form:

1. **NEATLY PRINT** your LEGAL first and last names, your counselor's name, your ID # and today's date.
2. **REQUIRED CLASSES** – English and US History are required **core** classes for 11th grade students. Math & Science classes are recommended, but not required if the appropriate 2 years have already been completed. The remaining courses should be considered after discussing options with your counselor. It is also recommended that you review the descriptions and prerequisites through our course catalog found on the JFK website: www.jfk.scusd.edu.
3. **ALTERNATE COURSES** - Sometimes classes become full, unavailable, OR are in direct conflict with your first 6 selections. Because of this, it is very important that you choose up to 1-2 additional alternate courses. You will receive 1 of these 2 alternate courses **IF** 1 of your original 6 choices is not available.
4. **PHYSICAL EDUCATION** – Due to limited space, *if you have already completed two years of PE*, the school cannot guarantee placement in a PE course as an elective.
5. **PREREQUISITES** – Please review the prerequisites in the course catalog for the classes you choose. Some courses offered will not allow you to take the second level of a course until you have completed the first level, or require that you have completed specific math or science levels or require that you submit an application to be accepted in to the class.
6. **ADVANCED / AP / SPECIALITY COURSES** – Please speak with your current teachers for their recommendations before requesting *Advanced or AP* courses. AP courses require at least a B or better in the previous college preparatory class, or a C or better in a previous Advanced or AP course. Selecting 4 or more AP courses will NOT be allowed WITHOUT your counselor's approval. If you want to be admitted to specialty classes like AP Art Studio, Jazz Band, Orchestra, etc., review the prerequisites and talk to the teacher of the intended class for approval.

If parents, legal guardians or students have questions, we recommend speaking to a counselor by making an appointment online at www.jfk.scusd.edu OR by email or phone. Each counselor is assigned by student last name. (See Below)
