## HOW TO ACCUMULATE POINTS

- HOMEWORK, CLASS WORK, PROJECTS, ETC. (30%) Assignments will be completed using the assigned text, workbook tear outs and handouts. Practice assignments should be completed daily and are due as a packet each Friday. As long as we stay "in-person", assignments will be "in-person". In the event we go back to "distance learning", all assignments will be turned in to google classroom. Late homework will be accepted the next class period for reduced credit. It is the student's responsibility to check the accuracy of their work. We will go over homework on a daily basis.
- ASSESSMENTS (70%): Tests will cover about 2 weeks' worth of material. Tests will be given weekly up to 4 times. Your 2 best scores will be kept. Quizzes may be given occasionally. A comprehensive final exam will be given at the end of each semester.

## ATTENDANCE

Attending class every day and being on time is critical. Students missing class miss out on notes, homework
assignments and explanation of new material. Attendance will be taken daily and reported to the attendance
office. Missed assignments will be accepted for full credit only if the absence is excused. Punctuality will also be
monitored. Tardiness will be handled according to school policy.

## **STUDENT PROGRESS:**

• Student progress will be closely monitored. In addition to the school's reporting process I will maintain grades in Infinite Campus online every week.

## CLASSROOM BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS

- Attend class every day.
- Complete all assignments on time.
- Be seated and prepared for learning when the bell rings.
- Treat classmates with respect; no put downs of any kind.
- Actively and positively participate in class.
- Demonstrate personal responsibility, honesty, and integrity in all of your actions.

## CLASSROOM RULES

- Follow teacher directions and requests immediately.
