#### **4. GENERAL OVERVIEW**

**Course Description:** Students will continue the study of French through total communication: speaking, listening, reading, writing, singing and doing projects. Class participation, which is very important, takes the form of drills, skits, songs, group work, conversation, and games. Homework will be assigned to re-enforce new material. There will be written and oral assessments.

#### **5. COURSE OBJECTIVES**

In French 2, students will be reviewing and expanding on language skills and cultural concepts introduced in French 1. This course also includes composition, reading, and practice in the spoken language. The focus is on comprehension, expression, and vocabulary building.
