It fills me with pride to emphasize that participation in the graduation ceremony is an esteemed privilege exclusively granted to students who have fulfilled all necessary criteria. Kindly review the following details attentively.

The graduation ceremony is a prestigious event meant to honor the hard work and achievements of the graduating class. Participation is a privilege reserved for students who have demonstrated dedication, responsibility, and commitment to their education.

Completion of Requirements: Participation in the graduation ceremony is reserved for students who have successfully completed all graduation requirements. This includes fulfilling the 225 credits required to graduate. If you are unsure of your status, please see your counselor immediately. In addition, all seniors must fill out a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or sign the opt out form.

Behavior Standards: Students must maintain appropriate behavior throughout the academic year leading up to the graduation ceremony. This includes adherence to school rules and policies, respectful interactions with faculty, staff, and peers, and participation in positive contributions to the school community. Any student who is suspended in the 4th quarter of the 2023-24 school year will not be permitted to attend the graduation ceremony. In addition, all outstanding detentions must be fulfilled.

Attendance Standards: Attendance is crucial for students to be eligible for participation in the graduation ceremony. Students must meet the minimum attendance requirements as outlined by the school administration. All graduating seniors must maintain a 90% attendance rate during the 4th quarter of the school year.

It is important for parents/guardians to discuss these standards with their student to ensure understanding and compliance. Parents/guardians should encourage their student to uphold the behavior and attendance expectations and to prioritize meeting all graduation requirements. Students who are uncertain about their eligibility for participation in the graduation ceremony are encouraged to seek clarification from their school counselor. Any concerns or questions regarding eligibility should be addressed as soon as possible to ensure appropriate guidance and support. By adhering to these standards and requirements, students can fully enjoy the honor and celebration of their graduation from Kennedy High School.
