



- Must be 18 years old or high school graduate
- No ACT, SAT, or GPA requirements
- Save money during first two years of college
- Effective transfer plans in place to CSU, UC, and private colleges and universities
- 1-2 year certification programs offered
- Los Rios





4 Year Colleges/Universities



UC/CSU Minimum Subject Requirements (A-G courses)

- A. 2 years History/Social Science
- B. 4 years English
- C. 3 years Math (through Math 3)
- D. 2 years Lab Science (1 Physical/1 Life) (3 years recommended)
- E. 2 years World Language (3 years recommended)
- F. 1 year Visual/Performing Arts (year-long course)
- G. 1 year Elective
- *** C or higher



SAT and ACT

- SAT-ACT <u>www.actstudent.org</u>
- Students should have already taken an SAT Exam at JFK this school year
- UCs and CSUs are not accepting scores for admission purposes.
- Private Colleges/Universities may require tests or be test optional
- Fee waivers available from your counselor
- Most colleges accept until December '23 test sitting
- Student MUST send official score reports from the College Board (SAT) or ACT to colleges/universities, scholarships and the NCAA.
- Four free score reports are included with registration.




University of California (UC)

- 3.0 gpa minimum for college prep classes taken in the 10th and 11th grades. C or better in A-G requirements (9th-12th grade).
- Comprehensive Review-The UC Campuses use criteria that exceed the minimum A-G requirements to select students.

- Personal Insight Questions are required for application (no letters of recommendation) 8 questions, applicants respond to 4




California State University (CSU)

- Minimum GPA is 2.0 in A-G (college prep) courses taken during the 10th & 11th grades Chances are much better with 2.5 or higher
- Meeting minimum A-G requirements (9th-12th grade)
- No essay or letter of recommendation
- Admission advantages given to local students
- Impaction

Private Colleges/Universities

- Over 68 private colleges in California
- The Common Application works for over 900 colleges/universities in the U.S.
- HBCUs and out of state colleges and universities
- AICCU (Assoc. of Ind. Ca. Colleges)



Private College/University tips



- Commonly require the same courses as UC & CSU/but check college website
- Usually require letters of recommendation-make sure to give teachers/counselors
 AT LEAST 3 weeks notice
- Include 9th grade when calculating a student's GPA
- May require SAT/ACT or possibly consider optional
- Require a mid-year report that includes senior year grades
- See specific college/university website for details.
- Often offer early and regular admission. Early admission deadline is usually in November or December. Can sometimes offer financial benefits.
- Early Decision: Only one college, binding
- Early Action: similar to early decision, non-binding

Financial Aid



- Grants: Cal, Pell, college/university, others
 Based on Financial Need- FAFSA/CADA
- Scholarships: college/university, private, other
 Based on merit, need, other factors
 Application/recommendations
- Loans: Federal (Stafford, Perkins), private
- DREAM Act and AB 540

- School will submit Cal Grant GPA Verification

Winter

- Continue applying to private colleges regular admission
- Continue scholarship applications
- Submit mid-year transcripts to private schools
- Apply to community colleges






Spring
