**Objective:** Students will be able to listen, read, write, and speak some basic phrases and sentences in Spanish. In this course students will work on the four skills by doing grammar and listening exercises, dialogs, skits, and reading and writing in the target language.

**Classroom expectations:** Students will attend and be appropriate in dress and behavior.
