HOW TO ACCUMULATE POINTS:

- Assessments (50%): This category includes unit tests, quizzes, group activities, finals, and any projects that students work on throughout the year.
- Khan Academy (20%): Khan Academy will be used together with in-class handouts to provide students with the opportunity to practice newly learned concepts. Students will be graded based on how many questions they were able to answer correctly; however, they will have the option to retry for a better grade.
- Homework/Classwork (15%): This category accounts for any handouts that are given to students
 throughout the week. Assignments must be stamped for completion and corrected to receive full
 credit. All handouts are collected on Friday. Late work is accepted at any time for half credit.
- Basic Skills Tests (10%): A couple of times a semester, students will be required to take what is
 known as a Basic Skills Test. This is a short assessment consisting of basic problems, i.e. no word
 problems. Students <u>must</u> get all problems correct on the Basic Skills Test to receive credit for it.
 However, students will have unlimited attempts at retaking the Basic Skills Test, and can even
 schedule to take it outside of class time.
- Math Dictionary (5%): The Math Dictionary is a notebook that students will be allowed to access during tests. It may contain definitions of vocabulary as well as example problems. It will be collected for grading every time we take a test.

ATTENDANCE

Attending class every day and being on time are critical. Students missing class miss out on notes, homework assignments and explanation of new material. Attendance will be taken daily and reported to the attendance office. Punctuality will also be monitored. Tardiness will be handled according to school policy.
