The Spanish 3 class will be covering the following topics:

Semester one: Present tense, present/past progressive tenses, past tense, future tense, present/past perfect tenses and other topics related to nouns, pronouns, adjectives, possessive adjectives, etc...

Semester two: Subjunctive mood and other topics related to the Spanish speaking culture.

Course Objectives:

Students will be able to continue enriching their Spanish knowledge (listening, reading, writing and speaking) by acquiring more vocabulary, grammar and cultural information throughout the academic year.
