Summer School 2022 - What to Expect!

Enrollment/ Scheduling

Students who wish to enroll in Summer School should visit or contact the counseling office to be placed on a waiting list. Live courses (such as PE) cannot be added past Tuesday, July 5th. Students on the waiting list will be contacted when space is available.

Check-In/ First Day

Students attending with us will enter through the cafeteria gate near the bike racks where they will see their classroom assignments. Students can also check their classroom/teacher assignments on infinite campus once scheduling has been completed. Students will then be directed to their classroom or the black top (PE only). Important Note: Students enrolled in PE should be dressed appropriately and are encouraged to bring water bottles. Students that arrive after the first day should check in at the counseling or front office before going to class.

Attendance/ Course Completion

Students must attend every day to remain enrolled. Students that miss more than (2) days may be disenrolled to allow more students from the waiting list to attend. Students that miss more than (3) days of a live class may be disenrolled. Students who miss school due to illness may need to work out makeup coursework with their teacher and submit documentation of illness from a physician.

For credit recovery, once all required/ enrolled courses are complete the summer school counselor will contact the parent/ guardian to inform them that the student has completed all requirements and no longer needs to attend.

Grading

With the exception of live classes, all other course grading is completed through AccelerateEducation. Students can monitor their progress at any time through a computer with internet access. Live class grading will be updated through infinite campus. Please connect with your student's teacher if you have more questions regarding grading.

Breaks and Passes

There will be two breaks throughout the day. Much like passing periods during a normal school day, students will be allowed to step outside and use the restroom during this time. Only certain areas on campus will be accessible to summer school students. Continue reading to see a campus map and accessible areas. If a student is out of class during any other time throughout the day, they must carry a pass from their teacher.

Student Technology/ Chromebooks

Students in credit recovery need to have access to their chromebooks everyday and charge it at home. Loaners will be available, but will be limited. Students will only be able to use a loaner on campus and will need to return it before leaving.

Breakfast/ Lunch

Breakfast will be available for students in the main office, counseling office and teacher classrooms.

Lunch will also be provided at dismissal as a grab and go option. Students will be able to pick up lunch on their way out from the gate near the cafeteria and bike rack.

Campus Map/ Summer Access

John F. Kennedy High School is a closed campus. All students on campus for summer school must be enrolled in summer school. Students must stay in their classrooms or authorized areas only - failure to do so may result in consequences up to removal from summer school.

PE Student Special Considerations

PE students will not have access to the locker rooms and will be expected to arrive dressed ready for PE participation starting on Day 1 (Thursday, June 30th). The PE teacher will go over all other dress expectations and requirements when class begins. All students are encouraged to bring a water bottle this is especially true for students in PE. We have water filling stations on campus.

Student Entrance and Exit to Campus

All students must enter campus through the cafeteria gate. This gate is located on the west side of campus near the bike racks, which you can access from the student parking lot. The greenbelt gate at the back of campus will be locked at all times and not accessible to students.
