4. GENERAL OVERVIEW

Course Description: Students will begin the study of French through total communication: speaking, listening, reading, writing, singing and doing projects. Class participation, which is very important, takes the form of drills, skits, songs, group work, conversation, and games. Homework will be assigned to re-enforce new material. There will be written and oral assessments.

5. COURSE OBJECTIVES

In French 1 we develop your ability and competency to read, write, speak and understand French. Students develop an awareness and appreciation of French culture: music, art, literature, film, food.

6. COURSE REQUIREMENTS, ATTENDANCE AND SPECIFIC GRADING POLICY

- 1. Come to class every day!!!!**
- 2. Participate** actively.
- Speak up & **speaK French** as frequently as possible, with the teacher and your classmates.
- Complete ALL** class work, homework, and projects.
- Keep a **French binder** with **four sections: ORAL, GRAMMAR, VOCABULARY, and CULTURE.**
- Bring French binder, French book, a pencil and a pen EVERY DAY.**
- Respect and **follow the class rules:**

RESPECT (yourself, others, the classroom), RESPONSIBILITY (attend class, focus, no electronics), PARTICIPATION (no electronics, no food or drinks, just water)

CLASS MATERIALS (What Do I Need for This Class?)

- 10 Pencils and 3 or 4 pens, YOU PROVIDE**
- 1 small/medium three ring Binder with 4 dividers, YOU PROVIDE**
- Binder paper, YOU PROVIDE**
- 3 Dry Erase Markers (if you can)
- 100 Index cards (if you can)

TESTS: There will be both written and oral exams. All tests, big or small, will be announced in advance. **MAKE-UP of a missed test will occur on THURSDAYS ONLY at lunch and only with an excused absence.** ALL MISSED TESTS must be made-up within two weeks of the actual test date.

HOMEWORK: Homework will be assigned nightly, that is **EVERY DAY**, and given at the end of class with time for students to begin. **Homework will be checked for completeness and points at the beginning of each day.** **LATE HOMEWORK will be accepted ONLY on Wednesdays at lunch and with AN EXCUSED ABSENCE** (due to illness, appointments, emergencies, or sports).

Your Grade: All homework, quizzes, finals, participation, projects, and class activities are counted towards your grade.
