4. GENERAL OVERVIEW

Course Description: Students will begin the study of French through total communication: speaking, listening, reading, writing, singing and doing projects. Class participation, which is very important, takes the form of drills, skits, songs, group work, conversation, and games. Homework will be assigned to reenforce new material. There will be written and oral assessments.

5. COURSE OBJECTIVES

In French 1 we develop your ability and competency to read, write, speak and understand French. Students develop an awareness and appreciation of French culture: music, art, literature, film, food.

6. COURSE REQUIREMENTS, ATTENDANCE AND SPECIFIC GRADING POLICY

- 1. Come to class every day ... even when it's online!
- 2. Participate actively.
- 3. Speak up & **speak French** as frequently as possible, with the teacher and your classmates.
- 4. Complete ALL class work, homework, and projects.
- 5. Keep a French binder with four sections: ORAL, GRAMMAR, VOCABULARY, and CULTURE.
