### Course description

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Integrated Math I is a requirement for graduation from John F. Kennedy High School. In this class, you will learn about:

- Relationships Between Quantities
- Linear and Exponential Relationships
- Reasoning with Equations
- Descriptive Statistics
- Congruence, Proof, and Constructions
- Connecting Algebra and Geometry Through Coordinates

### Required and Recommended Materials

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You will need:

1. Pencils (pens are ok but not recommended)
2. Scientific Calculator
3. Paper (a notebook or binder to keep organized is recommended)
4. Graph Paper (optional but recommended)
5. Ruler
6. Integrated Math I Workbook (provided by the school but you must bring to class every day)

### Grading Policy

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A = 90% – 100%    B = 80% - 89%    C = 70% - 79%    D = 60 – 69%    F = 59.9% and lower (no credit)

Grades will be broken up into four categories:

- Homework: 30% of your grade
- Progress Assessments: 30% of your grade
- In Class Participation/Notes/Assignments: 30% of your grade
- Final: 10% of your grade
